

Almost a Great Escape





My mother's name was Alice Tyler. The story of her 'One Good Thing' starts at her funeral in March 2004 and ends 60 years earlier in March 1944, when 76 WWII airmen broke out of Stalag Luft III, known as The Great Escape. This is the story of one of only three who made it home and the love story that remained hidden for seven decades.



Tyler grew up in Calgary and began writing as a reporter and editor in the 1970s, first with The Calgary Herald, then in Australia with The Australian. *Almost A Great Escape*, the winner of the 2014 Alberta Readers' Choice Award, the 2014 Writers Guild of Alberta, the Wilfrid Eggleston Nonfiction Award, and the 2014 The City of Calgary's W.O. Mitchell Book Award.
