

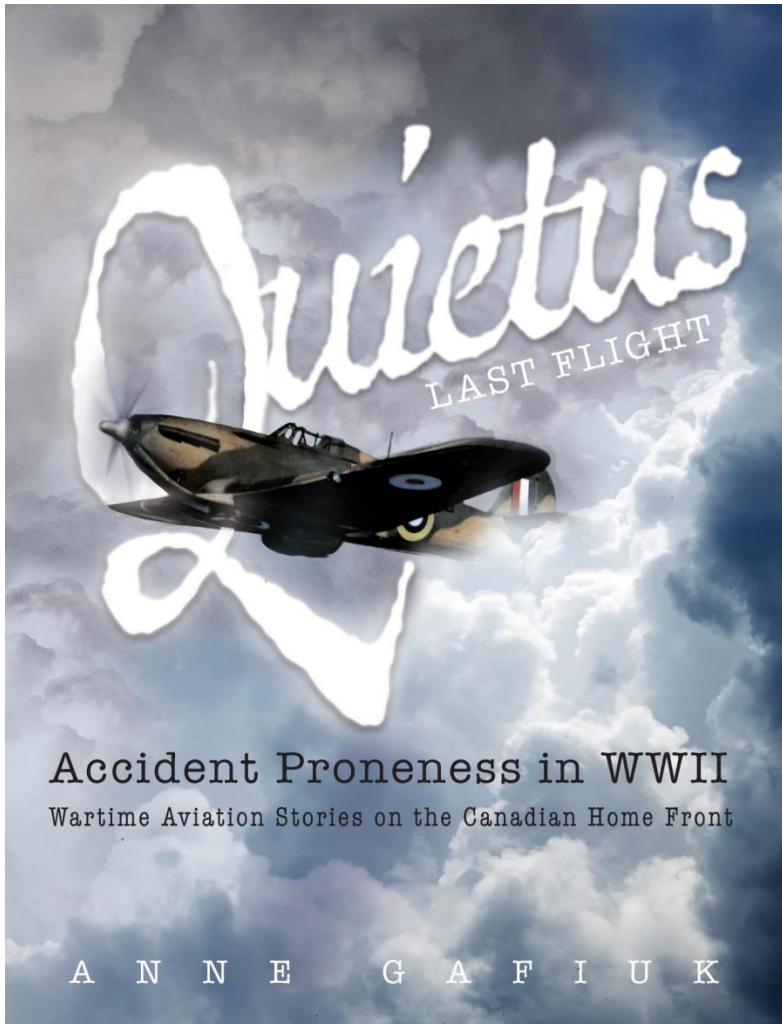

Quietus: Last Flight



In 1948, a decorated WWII navigator returned to university to finish his medical degree. As part of his studies he investigated accident proneness, looking at the crashes of sixteen RCAF pilots during the war.

Anne recreated Hugh Burns Hay's thesis, combing details of the accidents, the Courts of Inquiry, plus updated information from military sources and families of the pilots and crew members.



Anne Gafiuk is a former school teacher from Calgary who turned to freelance writing. During her research into WWII RCAF pilots, she became interested in vintage aircraft, the people involved with them and their history, taking her on a new flight of discovery. Anne is the author of Wings Over High River and She Made Them Family.
