



OTTAWA CHAPTER CANADIAN AVIATION HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Canadian Aviation Historical Society (CAHS) is a federally-chartered non-profit organization dedicated to the preservation and publication of Canada's aviation history. The Ottawa Chapter of the CAHS was formed in 1964 to promote these goals within Canada's National Capital Region and, when appropriate, nationally and internationally. Today, the Ottawa Chapter has more than 300 members, some of whom live outside the region.

Regular monthly meetings are the most significant part of the Ottawa Chapter's activities. These are held on the last Thursday of the month from September through May (*except December*) in the Bush Theatre of the Canada Aviation Museum, Rockcliffe Airport. The meetings feature guest speakers, films, slide shows, book signings, and visits to the restoration workshops of the Museum. Our speakers present both first-person accounts and researched papers covering all historical periods and aspects of aviation. Recent talks have dealt with the Canadian use of specific military and civil aircraft, squadron and company histories, and the noteworthy aviation experiences of people from the Ottawa-area. Each meeting is summarized and the next advertised in the Ottawa Chapter newsletter, *The Observair*, which is mailed to all members. *The Observair* also presents short historical articles and notes by members, informs members of aviation events in the Ottawa-area, offers news and reviews of aviation books, as well as notice of other articles of aviation or historical interest.


In addition, the Ottawa Chapter has an informal Research and Projects Group which meets monthly to discuss issues or projects of individual interest to members and an Air Show Crew to staff a Chapter display at air and aviation trade shows. The Ottawa Chapter also routinely hosts the Canadian Aviation Historical Society's Annual Convention.

The Ottawa Chapter of the Canadian Aviation Historical Society draws its members from the ranks of serving and former military and civil aircrew, the aviation industry, artists, photographers, modellers, and professional and amateur historians. The Chapter and its members are interested in all aspects of Canada's aviation history, from the earliest flights to modern times. New members will be sure to meet others who share their interests. We make a special effort to ensure that new members are made welcome. Please join us and see for yourself!
