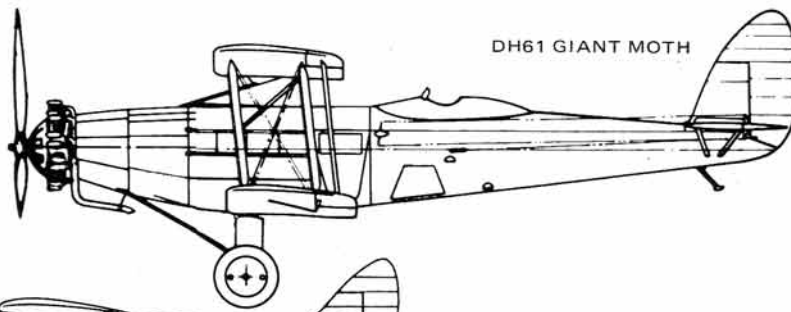

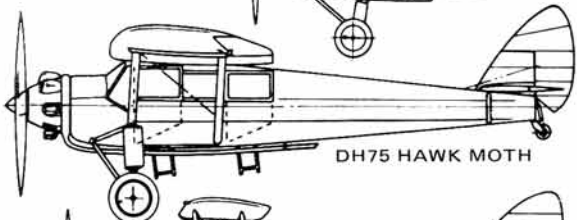

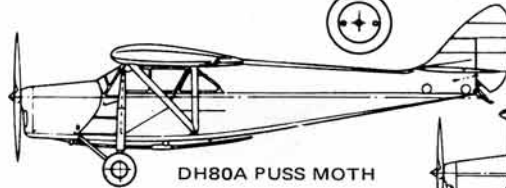
DH60G GIPSY MOTH



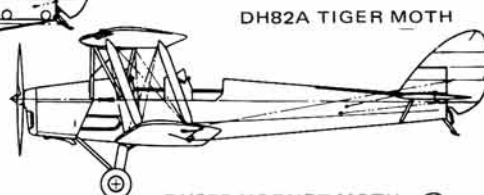

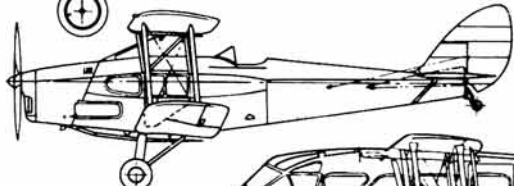

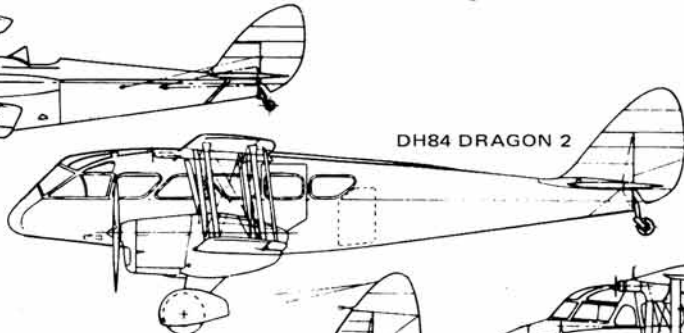

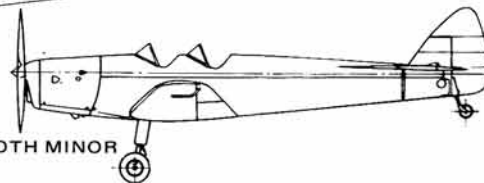

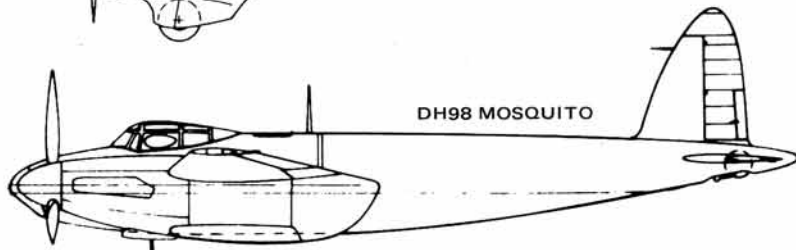
