Treasurer's Annual Report, 2021

This year continued to be one of uncertainty. Several times when it looked like we would again be able to meet in person, COVID-19 put and end to those aspiration. As the chapter only met virtually, our expenses were for the Observair, some calendars for our presenters as a token of our appreciation and for books in support of January 2022's presentation. Our revenue was limited to membership fees, donations and some book sales.

At the end of the year the chapter had \$ 7,757.35 in the Cdn account, \$ 427.22 in the US dollar and \$ 133.71 in petty cash (Yes, there are still some pennies in the cashbox). This meant a profit of \$ 144.34 Cdn and 23 cents USD (due to interest).

Revenue was lower than expected because of decreasing membership. This affected the postage and printing costs as there were fewer members receiving a paper copy of the Observair. Some expenses disappeared, such as the coffee and donuts as we only met virtually this past year.

We are still looking for ways to spend some of our funds to promote the CAHS and aviation history in Ottawa. If you have any ideas, please let us know.

The presentation year changed to coincide with the calendar year. All memberships were automatically extended. This made it simpler for your treasurer. Membership fees are now being accepted for the 2022 presentation year. Finally, there is no increase in the cost of membership for this coming year (2022).
