## **PWA *Hercules* Operations, 1966 – 1984**



Pacific Western Airlines was the first commercial operator of the civilian Lockheed *Hercules* L100 cargo aircraft in Canada in 1967. Over 17 years, PWA flew 6 aircraft into 108 countries, amassing more than 90,000 air hours and 26 million miles, hauling over 800,000 tonnes of outsized cargo, bulk fuel and livestock. A very rare topic, not to be missed!



Stuart Russell spent 29 years at PWA and 10 years as Loadmaster and Project Manager for their *Hercules* operations. An expert in Arctic logistics, he now focuses on remote mining, sealift and oil and gas exploration projects with aircraft
