Dominique Prinnet began his flying career in France in the 1960s before emigrating to British Columbia at the age of 25, where he became a commercial pilot and instructor. From 1967 to 1971 he was a bush pilot flying Beavers, Otters, and Beech 18 aircraft on wheels, floats, and skis out of Yellowknife, Northwest Territories. His new book, *Flying to Extremes: Memories of a Northern Bush Pilot*, has just been released in March 2021.
