Rae Churchill's War: Dropping Supplies, Spies and Towing Gliders on D-Day



Rae joined the RCAF in September 1940 and stayed with it for 27 years. In that time he instructed in the BCATP, got overseas in April 1943 and joined 295 Squadron of the RAF flying Whitleys, Albemarles and Sterlings on special ops. Post war he flew Northstars with 414 and 426 Squadrons and participated in the Korean Air Lift and much more.



Rae's logbook details over 8000 hours in 20 different aircraft types. He was awarded the 1939-1945 Star, Air Crew Europe Star with France and Germany Clasp, United Nations Service Medal with Korean Clasp, Canadian Forces Decoration and Clasp and Netherlands Flying Cross.
