Built in Canada and serving with a combat squadron defending our west coast, Hurricane 5389 was flown by one of Canada's highest scoring aces of WWII. This rare bird has a very storied past including being at the center of a multi-million dollar law suit and a scam that would have seen it sent to England. Now under restoration to run and taxi status the Hurricane is scheduled for completion this year.
