## Cub Aircraft: Canada's Flivverplane 1936 - 1949 Cameron Price

Cub Aircraft Corporation Limited was formed in Hamilton in 1936, assembling Taylor and later Piper aircraft under license with parts shipped from the United States. The factory and small flying school were located on the eastern boundary of the city. Throughout the war, Cub Aircraft continued to assemble and repair aircraft, as well as train pilots. Despite post-war optimism, high sales of civilian aircraft never materialised, and within four years, the Cub Aircraft company would cease to exist.
