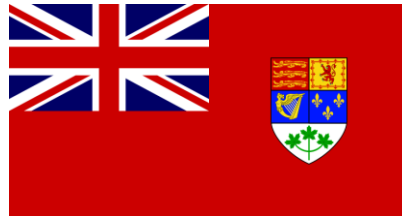
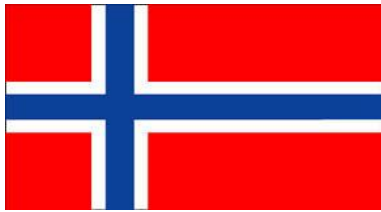

After Norway was occupied in April 1940, an aircrew training base was established in Canada to train those who escaped and those of Norwegian origin already in Canada. Over 2000 graduated to form four squadrons which joined in the fight to regain their homeland.
