John Fauquier DSO and 2 Bars DFC was the most decorated Canadian airman of World War II. He served almost four years and flew at least 93 operations with Bomber Command, initially flying twin-engined bombers and concluding his career commanding the legendary 'Dambusters' squadron as they dropped 22,400 pound 'Grand Slam' earthquake bombs.



Dave Birrell is a geophysicist, teacher, and interpretive guide in the Canadian Rockies. Dave has been associated with the Bomber Command Museum of Canada since its beginning. He is the author of several books related to the history of Bomber Command, the BCATP, and the museum as well as three books about the mountains of the Canadian Rockies.
